- **Brief Report:**

The **Botany Department**, according to **Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati** Syllabus; successfully organized educational visit and which conducted by Head of the Department **Dr. U.R.Kokate** on **29 September 2023** for **B.Sc. Part- 1-, 2- & 3-year** students at Amzari Forest to enhance students' interest in botany and provide practical learning experiences. Students worked hard to collect class-work plant material from the field. They also gathered information about the various uses of these plants.

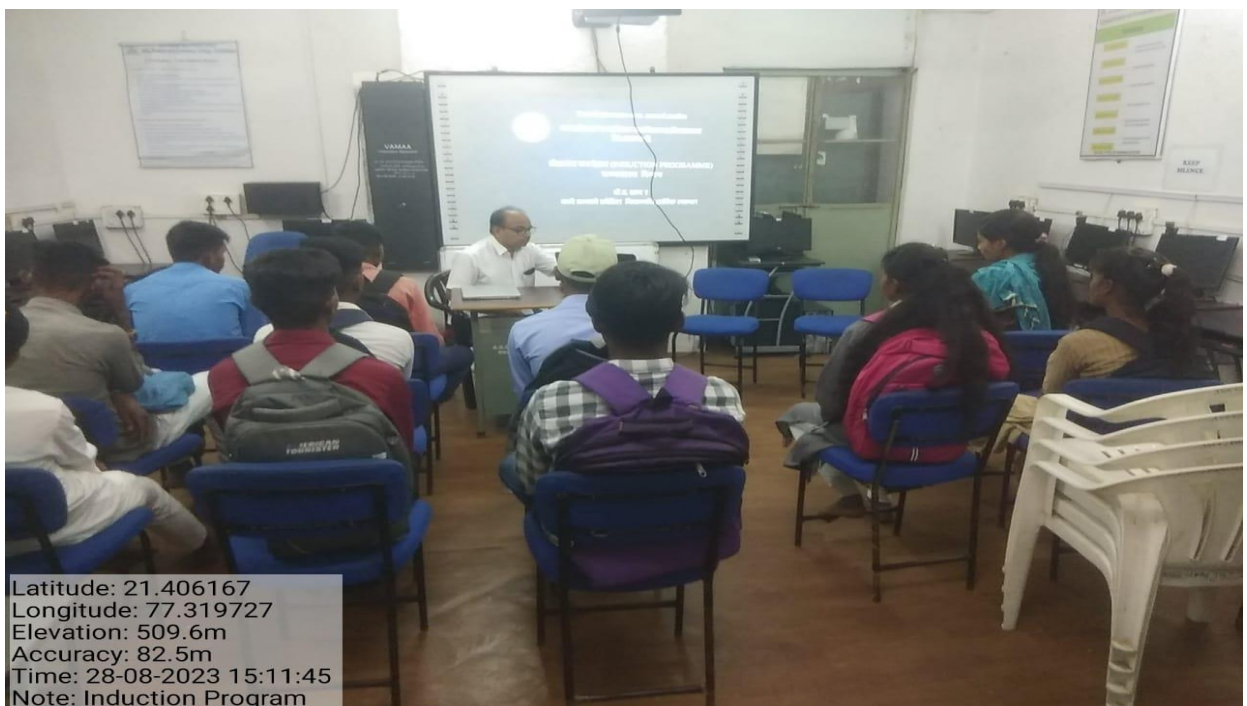
