#### **Brief Report: -**

The College conducted a Student Induction Programme for the academic year 2023-24 on 28/08/2023, catering to students from the Arts, Science, and Commerce faculties. 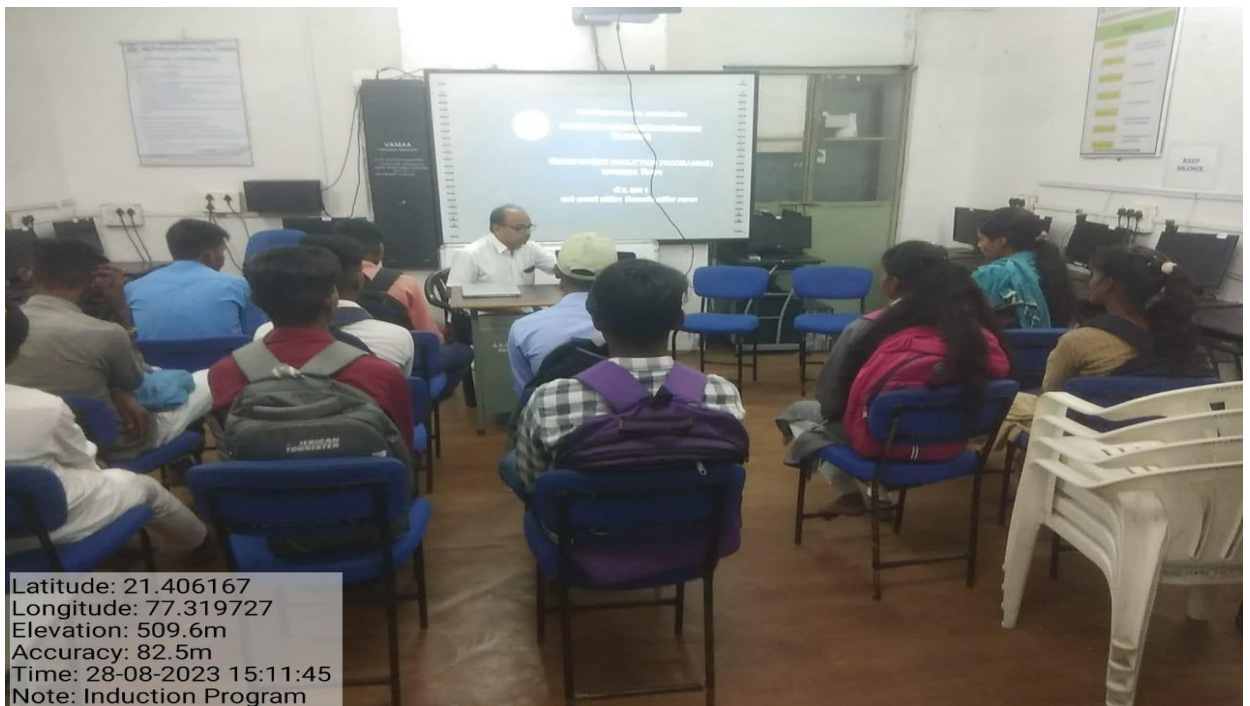

## General Discipline and Rule of Conduct for Students

1. विद्यार्थ्यांनी महाविद्यालयाच्या व्यवस्थेसंबंधीची माहिती प्रसिद्धीकरिता देता कामा नये. अशा प्रकारात विद्यार्थी दोषी आढळल्यास त्यांचेवर शिस्तभंगाची कार्यवाही होईल. विद्यार्थ्यांच्या महाविद्यालयातील तसेच बाहेरील असभ्य वर्तणुकीची गंभीर दखल घेतली जाईल.

2. According to Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act. No. 33, 15th May 1999, UGC regulation on curbing the menace & ragging in higher educational institutions, 2009/17 June 2009. "Ragging" is strictly prohibited. "Ragging" means display of disorderly conduct, doing of any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological or raise apprehension of fear or shame or embarrassment to a student in any educational institution and includes : i) Teasing, abusing, threatening or play practical jokes on, or causes hurt to, such student; ii) Asking a student to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course, willingly, do.

- **Prohibition of Ragging:** Ragging within or outside of any educational institution is prohibited.

- **Penalty for Ragging :** Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propogates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to 2 years and shall also be liable to fine which may extend to Rs. 10,000/-

- **Dismissal of Student :** Any student convicted on an offence under section 4 shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of 5 years from the date of order of such dismissal.

- **Suspension of Students:** If the student is found guilty in such cases he/she shall be terminated from institution.

(For Teachers, Non-Teaching Staff and Stake holders) Discrimination against S.C./S.T. students and any other community or category of students is strictly prohibited in the college campus.

3. Student should make careful use of college books, room, furniture, fans, laboratory equipments and the college property in general. The cost of damage done to it would be recoverable from students either individually or collectively as the case may be.

4. Students who cancel admission at any time for any reason shall have to pay tuition fees and other for the whole session.

5. Students shall have to obey all the instructions by the Principal. They will be directly answerable to him for their behaviour in general, both inside and outside the college. The names of such students found violating the rules of the college administration or behaving in an indisciplined manner will be removed from the college rolls. It will be presumed on admission that the students are concerned with these rules.



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6. Student have to carry their Identity Card all the time with them in the campus.
7. Smoking, Gutka Chewing are strictly prohibited. Offenders shall be liable to face legal action.
8. Students are prohibited from forming associations/organizations and from holding functions in the college without the prior permission of the Principal.
9. Student are prohibited from organizing welcome, farewell and other such functions outside college premises. Violation shall attract severe disciplinary actions.
10. No certificate of any kind will be issued unless full session fees are paid. Any amount paid by the student at the time of admission and later will not be refunded.
11. Dress Code / Uniform - The College has decided that all students of the college should strictly follow the dress code / unifrom (Sky Blue Shirt & Dark Blue Trouser for Boys / Sky Blue Kurta & White Salwar for Girls.)
