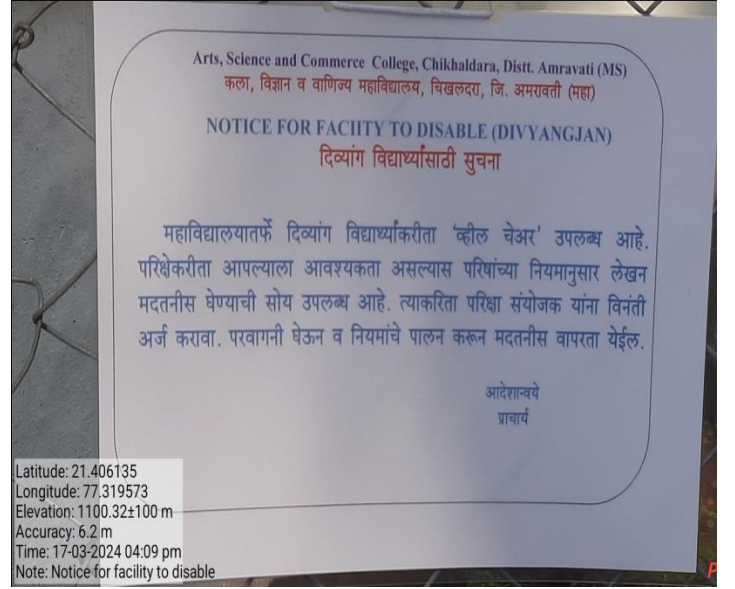

Policy statement on

Facilities for Disabled Students

The constitution of India has given equal rights to all Indians which ensures equality, freedom, justice and dignity of all individuals, therefore it is the most important thing to have proper policies and institutional mechanisms to promote all the students including disabled students (PwD) for facilitating them with equal opportunities as it is the vision of the institution to work for overall development of the people of Melghat and nearby areas through education.

Recently, the Government of India signed UNCRPD and enacted Rights of Persons with Disability Act 2016 that recognizes that the person with disability are entitled to equal opportunities and rights to participate in the political, social, economic and self-development activities in all walks of life. Keeping this in mind Arts, Science and Commerce College Chikhaldara proposed to take efforts behind the tribal students of the Melghat region where there is not only the problem of physical disability but also Malnutrition too. The basic aim of the Institution is to provide them all the equal opportunities who are deprived from their rightful opportunities.

The persons with Disability Act 1995 indicated that differently-abled persons should have access to education at all levels. In the higher education sector University Grand Commission (UGC) set up guidelines in this regard in XIIth plan. Therefore it is now mandatory for all universities and colleges to facilitate and empower differently-abled students like normal students and provide them equal opportunities.

Objectives:

- To provide barrier free environment for safe and reliable accessibility.
- To make aware and provide necessary guidance about various schemes, scholarships, fellowships and stipends given by the Central and State governments for the students with disability in every stream.
- Encourage them to build their own career, Skill development, Employment and Entrepreneurship.
- To run various schemes funded by UGC.
- To provide equal education opportunities
- To promote them for participating in cultural function and annual gathering to increase social inclusion.
- To provide special assistance to these students who belong to these categories.
- To take precautionary measures to create inclusive environment in the college and set up redressal mechanism for grievances reported by the students.

Modus Operandi: Facilitate differently-abled students for different course available in the college and provide the proper guidance counselling and ensure admission of as many disabled

students as possible through the open quota and also through the reservation meant for these students. Assess the educational needs of disabled students enrolled in the college and determine types of assistive devices to be procured. College will take efforts in collecting and dealing orders to help these students getting concessions in examination fees, reservation etc. pertaining to this category.

Facilities: Wheel Chair (1), Ramp and Toilet.

Feedback Mechanism: Feedback will be recorded and placed before the CDC members in the meeting or in the staff council meeting minutes in a transparent manner to initiate appropriate steps. The grievances will be resolved (if any) in the Action Taken with utmost priority.
