**REPORT**

In the session 2023-24 Admission Committee tried unbreakably to contact students of the Melghat region to bring them in higher education. As per the planning, our staff reached to the students in the villages of two tehsils of Melghat i.e. Dharni and Chikhaldara. Under this campaigning we visited nearby 105 villages. The visit was organized two times in the year i.e. from 17<sup>th</sup> July to 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 and 27<sup>th</sup> Jan to 10<sup>th</sup> Feb, 2024.

The villages were allotted to the group of teachers by giving the details of the schedule, pamphlets, etc. During the visit, we met the teachers (mostly of Junior colleges), students, alumni, and the key persons of the allotted villages. We also talked to the parents for sending their wards to higher education by counseling them. We collected the list of students and met them by going to their homes. While meeting with the Sarpanch, Police-Patil, Gramsevak, etc. we conveyed the opportunities and importance of higher education so that they can encourage the parents and students for taking higher education.

Apart from this visits, for us it is a continuous process throughout the year. We always keep contact by taking follow-up with all the people we met during the visits to increase their interest in higher education. As a part and parcel of this campaign we always ready to solve the difficulties regarding admission process or any related issue. We convinced many parents especially of girls to let their wards to pursue higher education. The reports submitted by the teachers are analyzed. Some issues that found behind the negligence/ unwillingness of these people for not taking the admissions to the higher education are as follows

- Many students go for the daily wages work to earn money and hence cannot attain the college regularly.
- Due to economically weak background most of students cannot afford the expenses
- Limited seats for the ST students in the Government hostels, other ST, SC, etc.
- These people are not willing to educate the girls as the girls get married as soon as they complete 18 years of age
- Inadequate transportation facilities

**Suggestions by the Committee**

- Need of increasing the seats in the ST hostels
- Need to provide the residential facilities to the poor students on minimum rates
- Need to provide some basic facilities such as Photo copy, print-outs, online document feeling, canteen on subsidies rates etc.


**Brief summary of the program:**





## Conservation of Medicinal plants

  3. To know current status of plants

  5. To propagate plants naturally.
- **Brief Report** :

Regarding our objectives we considered that the medicinal plants have long been integral to human health, providing raw materials for pharmaceuticals, traditional remedies, and nutritional supplements. However, rapid deforestation, habitat destruction, overharvesting, and climate change are threatening the existence of many plant species that are vital for medicine. The information of the plants is printed in the form of syllabus for college students. **The Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University** affiliated Colleges students of Botany, Ayurveda College students, as well as Forest department.

Local Melghat tribal people have knowledge of these medicinal plants. During the visits students get knowledge and collect data about how tribal people use these medicinal plants for the cure of their diseases.

Today many medicinal plants face extinction but detail information is lacking, so it is important to conserve and preserve the medicinal plants. To propagate and conservation such medicinal plants, in ex-situ manner in our botanical garden of ethnobotany, in program 40 Students were participated. Melghat Forest is tropical, dry, deciduous type forest. The soil and climate of **Chikhaldara plateau** is suitable for

medicinal plants. According our programme objectives we have taken step; Conserved some medicinal plants statistics are:

**Medicinal plants : 51 genera**  
**Aromatic plants : 05**  
**Grasses : 05**
